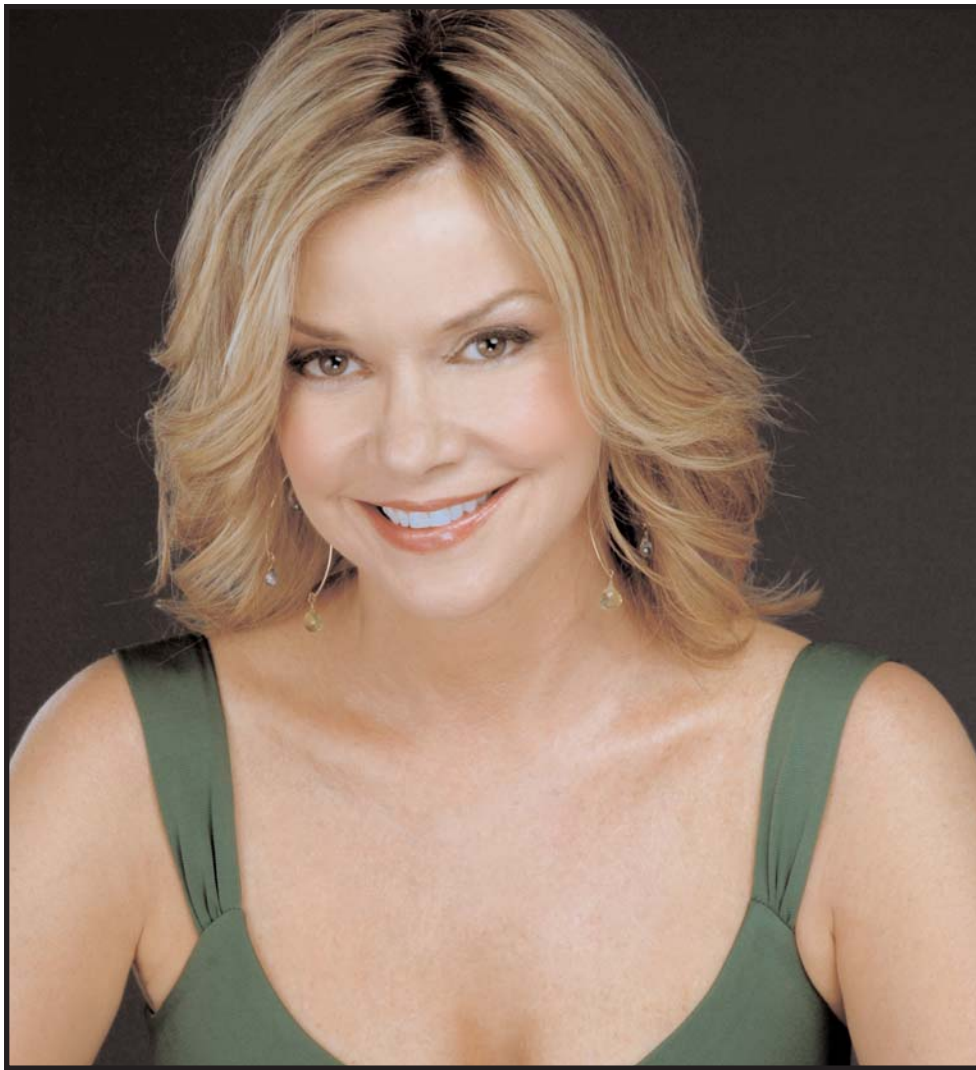

2012 Mistress of Ceremonies

Bobbie Eakes will visit Roanoke in June to Emcee the "Miss Virginia Pageant" 2012 Miss Virginia Pageant June 28-30 at the Roanoke Civic Center.

Bobbie Eakes is the youngest of five girls in an Air Force family. Her parents, Audrey and Bob, supported all their daughters when, as teens, they expressed interest in competing in Miss America Scholarship preliminaries. Her sister Sandra won the title of Miss Georgia in 1979, and Bobbie followed in her footsteps, becoming Miss Georgia in 1982. Going on to be named a top ten finalist in the Miss America Pageant, Bobbie was spotted by a Hollywood television producer, which paved the way for her career as an entertainer.

Early in her career, Bobbie was a guest star on TV shows including Cheers, Matlock, Jake and the Fatman, and The Wonder Years. At the same time, Bobbie was signed at Epic Records with her all-girl band, Big Trouble. The band released one self-titled CD and was featured on American Bandstand, as well as in the Montreux Pop Festival and regularly as the "house band" for the series Comedy Break.

Later, Bobbie won the role of Macy on the soap opera, The Bold and The Beautiful, which she played over a period of 14 years and which helped her career as an international recording artist. She has two double platinum CDs and has performed in concert throughout Europe. In the U.S., she recorded a duet with country singer Collin Raye and considers singing with him at the Grand Ole Opry one of the highlights of her career.

In 2003, Bobbie moved to New York to portray Krystal on the soap opera, All My Children, for which she won two Emmy nominations for Lead Actress. While in New York, she also recorded a smooth jazz CD, Something Beautiful, which debuted at number 21 on the Smooth Jazz charts.

Bobbie has always contributed much of her free time promoting charitable causes. Among her favorites are Broadway Cares/Equity Fights Aids, Ahope for Children, and Desert Aids Project. She resides in Palm Springs, Calif., with her husband of 20 years, actor and writer David Steen.

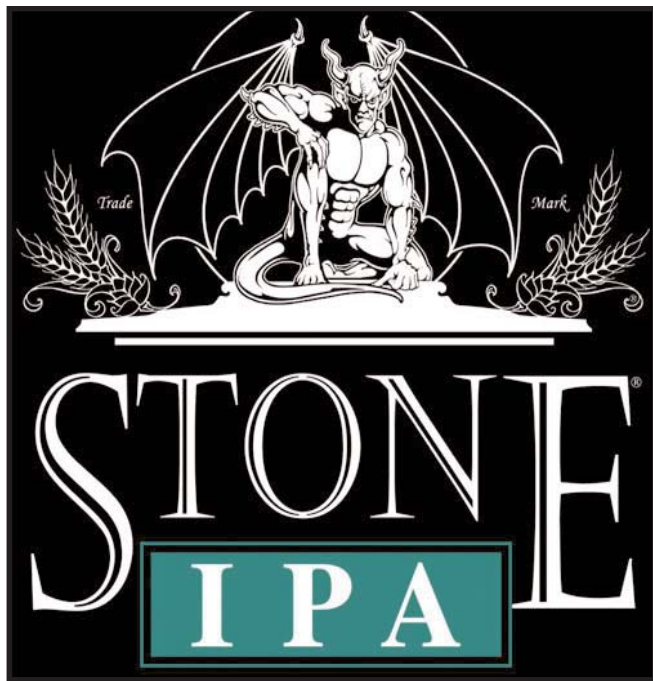

Dogfish Head 60-minute IPA: Again, if this were the NBA, Dogfish would win. Why? Not only does it have serious hops - many from the Pacific Northwest, by the way - the brewing process features 60 hop additions over a 60-minute boil. Hoppin' right out of the gym. But seriously, East Coast brewers tend to use more specialty malts, and this is evident in this 60-minute bottle of badness. Meaning that its contents constitute a near perfect blend of citrus and malt. Every sip brings a terrific grapefruit-like start with a malty, hoppy finish.

So who wins the first Bottle Royale? If the mascots got involved in this fight, it would be over quickly, and really, really ugly. Stone's impressive gargoyle would give the term "battered fish" new meaning. But it's a battle of the buds (taste buds, not the other Buds) ... and Dogfish wins by, well,

a head. Of the course this went the distance - all 24 ounces. In a matchup like this, everyone's a winner. Especially the people who do the tasting.

Battle of the Bottles

Craft beer matchup of the month: Stone IPA vs. Dogfish Head 60-minute IPA

If this were the NBA, it would be Magic vs. Bird, West Coast vs. East Coast, Lakers vs. Celtics. But this is IPA, and we're talkin' beers, not basketball. To celebrate the Virginia Beer Festival's return in May to Town Point Park, Splash Sports presents a mythical matchup, yet one that could potentially be all too real to one's taste buds.

On one side, from San Diego, it's Stone's India Pale Ale, or IPA. On the other, from Delaware, it's Dogfish Head's 60-minute IPA.

We had plenty of nicknames suggested for this "event." Bottlestar Galacticaand, Bottlefield Earth were rejected. We settled on Bottle Royale, because this truly is a meeting of craft beer royalty.

Stone IPA: A progressive and aggressive outfit based in San Diego, Stone produces a standard IPA that bears all of the classic hallmarks of the left coast brewing - dry and crisp, piney with resin, hops that zing your palate. The hop fields of the Pacific Northwest and all of their variety enable Stone to pack an IPA punch. Stone heavily promotes its Arrogant Bastard ale and its Ruination IPA, but this one stands up just fine to any competition.

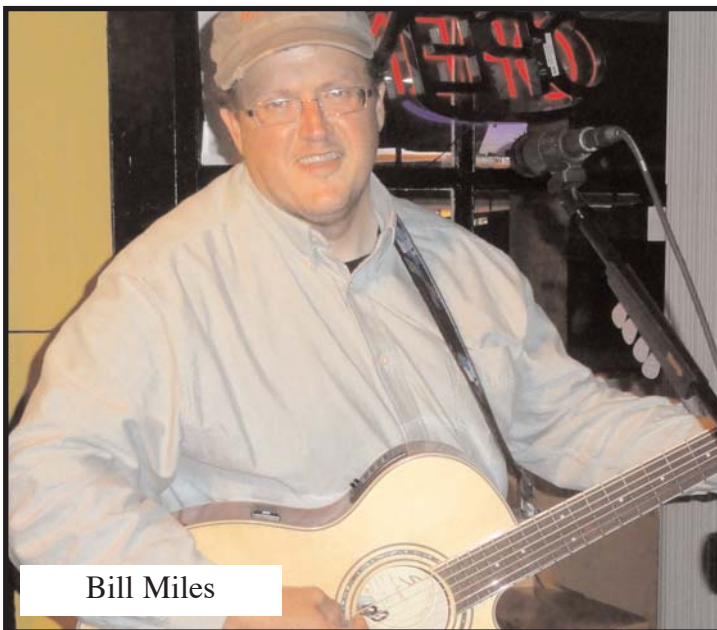
Singer Songwriter Showcase at The Hilton Tavern

I remember the first time I heard Bill Miles.

I was sitting in the back of the Hilton Tavern not focusing on much more than the craft beer in front of me, when I popped back into the real world. I heard a voice and some guitar. For an instant, I thought that maybe it was The Band, and that somebody had played the digital jukebox.

It was the band, all right. The Bill Miles Band. A flowing, sometimes rambling American-folk sound, with Miles' voice curling in and out of the material like a country creek. This was, as I would figure out later, all part of the Hampton Roads Songwriters

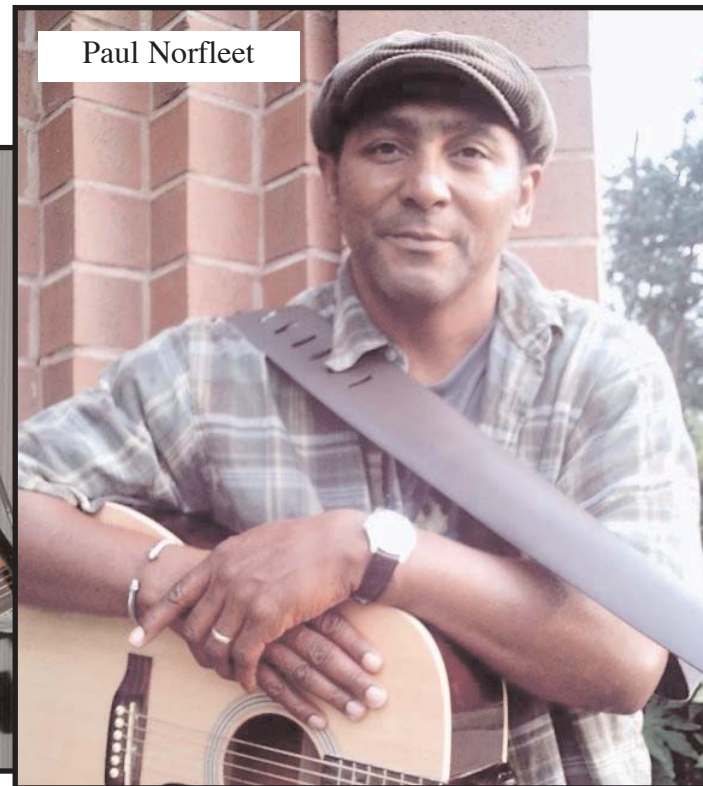
Showcase held on the last Saturday of each month at the Tavern, a beloved and historic establishment in Newport News' Hilton Village which under the new ownership of Lee Steveson has become quite the place for live music.

Miles was up on the "stage" in the front of the Tavern. He was the guy with the hat slung over his eyes singing and playing guitar, flanked by a bass player (Glenn Woodell) and harmonica player (Chad Rosenbrock). Drummer Kevin Irish must have had the night off. I watched the BMB do another song, then caught a rocker named Roy Moats. He did not sound like the Bill Miles Band or The Band or Dylan or Waylon, but he was pretty damn good as just himself. There were others - all earnest and heartfelt and accomplished.

Around a month later, I found myself again listening to Bill Miles. This time he was talking. It turns out that I had been assigned to do an article on the Hampton Roads Songwriters Showcase. Miles was definitely the guy to talk to; this was his baby from the start.

First glance: I had guessed that he was an accountant. He's an insurance

appraiser. A Poquoson guy but now a resident of Hilton Village. Forty-three, married to a music-loving wife, three children. During the interview, he came off as polite, friendly and helpful. And a little soft-spoken. At first. By the time we got around to the Showcase, his voice was at a pretty fair pitch. It doesn't take one long to figure out that Miles has a real passion for music. This format, Miles said, "allows singers and songwriters to come out and play their music. It's a very nice group of local musicians. ... Music is hard. You've got to work at it. These people have got to get out and play." Sure, the Showcase is just a glorified open mic night. So be it. I've sat through my share of un-glorified open mic nights (and some very good ones, too), and don't even get me started on karaoke. That's a way of saying that I don't know how you can not like this format and these performers.

There's Miles and his group. They've got about 30 solid, original songs to choose from, and from now on if I catch them live, I hope one will be "The River," one of those babe-let's-get-away-from-it-all folk charmers that has made it onto my MP3 player's go-list.

There's Paul Norfleet, a 50-something veteran folksman/bluesman/soul man who

committed full-time to his music career a couple of years ago. Bill Withers-meets-James Taylor-meets Richie Havens type. That's my best shot at categorizing him after hearing songs like "Daddy Wasn't Home" and "29th Street." He's accomplished, to say the least. At the Sea Level Singer-Songwriter Festival, Norfleet won the Emerging Artist category. Also, recently he was named a finalist in the folk category of the John Lennon Songwriting Contest. "What I notice about Paul, every time I see him play, is that his soul is close to the surface," said Miles. Norfleet's heart, or soul, is in the right place when it comes to participating in the Showcase. "It's wonderful," Norfleet said, "because you get to hear the young up-and-coming people, and then you get to hear the veterans. ... Oh, and I love to hear the women."

There's John Kovacevich, 32, a chief petty officer in the Coast Guard who at first glance appears to have arrived straight from the heartland. The reality is that he's been all over, and moved to Hampton Roads from Galveston, Texas, around a year ago. On stage, "Johnny Mud" plays guitar, harmonica, tambourine and drums - often at the same time. Bluesy at times, folksy at times, but with a rock-and-roll edge, his music is disarming. Seriously, you can't help but root for this guy and his next song.

Kovacevich, who said he enjoys the constructive feedback from other musicians at such events as the Showcase, looks forward to another good event at the Tavern. "If I'm not on duty, I'll be there."

"Eclectic" is overused, I realize, but honestly that's the word that keeps coming to mind when I think of this Showcase. You go from Miles, Norfleet and Mud to Chris Howard (rock and roll), Rob Crutchfield (folk rock), Clint Dye (gospel/spiritual), Chris Schultz (modernized Dylan-type) and Mark Green (folk/country). Miles says that in past showcases and open mics (which draw some of the same talent), hip-hop artists have shown up with their lyrics and laptops. Jack Burton Green may best exemplify the vibe of the Showcase. Nobody would fight you on that one. Green plays, as Miles puts it, "outlaw country" music. Green, 47, born and raised in Newport News, doesn't mind that tag but prefers "just plain American music." Years ago, he became a huge Lynyrd Skynyrd fan, "but I can't play Skynyrd" he explained with a laugh. What he really likes these days is Hank Williams III ("Hank Three") and Ray Wylie Hubbard. From these influences and so many more, Green has come forth with "My Application Song." Check it out. Straight-up rambling country chords complemented by some clever lyrics. Chances are you'll like it, and remember it. Both Miles and Norfleet, friends who often bounce ideas off

each other via phone calls, think the Hampton Roads area is fertile ground for the kind of talent on display recently at the Tavern. More showcases and many more open mic nights are scheduled all over the area. And there are thoughts of holding a big outdoor event. More than anything, these guys dream of situations like those of Austin, Texas, and Macon, Ga., and Branson, Mo., and Asbury Park, N.J., relatively modest locations that became known nationally as cool places that grew cool talent. If it happened there, why not here? Sounds like wishful thinking until you consider

the hip-hop/r&b explosion that originated from the 757: Timbaland (Virginia Beach), Missy Elliott (Portsmouth), The Neptunes (Virginia Beach), The Clipse (Virginia Beach). Maybe it could be a "mecca for songwriters," as Norfleet suggested. Maybe one day they'll write stories, make that songs, about what's in the James River water, and who really hangs out in Va-Beach, and the bridge-tunnels, and any stuff that Timbaland hasn't already covered. It's not as if there's a shortage of material around here.

For now, checking out a showcase or open mic night close to you will certainly



do for entertainment of the moment, while at the same time supporting your local artists. Keep watching and listening. One of those moments could well turn into a memory: when early greatness was glimpsed.

The Hoppiest Place on Earth

I'm not so much a beer snob as a beer geek.

I frequent beeradvo-
cate.com a lot. I've
toured three breweries
this year. I prefer dry-
hopping to cold-filtering.
I don't believe in the
vortex bottle or the vent-
ed wide-mouth can. The
champagne of beers to
me is Feldschlosschen
Hopfenperle. I want a
growler. I actually
enjoyed the movie "Beerfest." Other guilty
pleasure viewing: the most interesting man
in the world commercials. I mentally make notes on grocery and
convenience stores' beer selections. Likewise, I never miss a Steal
the Pint night at the local tavern. And I attend beer festivals, espe-
cially ones 35 minutes from my doorstep. On a sunny, breezy,
absolutely perfect Saturday afternoon in May at Town Point Park,
the 9th Annual Virginia Beer Festival was held. Around 7,000
people enjoyed a wide range of beer from more than 65 brewing
companies representing Hampton Roads, other parts of Virginia,
the U.S., and the world. This was my Disney World. The
Hoppiest Place on Earth.

I got a nice reception from the people in charge, and was issued
a wristband and a 4-ounce official festival tasting glass, just like
everyone over the age of 21 who paid \$30. I stood around for a few min-
utes and took in the scene. Almost ringing the park was a basic setup of
tents with beer vans and trucks parked behind them. Friendly faces man-
ning the taps. Friendly people milling around the taps, in polite lines
already.

People wearing pretzel necklaces. People wearing clever beer T-shirts.
The tasting was scheduled for 2-5:30 p.m. At around 1:45, none of the
lines were particularly long, so I got adventurous and wandered over to the
Belgian beer tents. Considering that I never drink Belgian beers, I really
don't know what got into me. Actually, I do know what got into me: 4
ounces of Weyerbacher Insanity (that's the name of the beer, but it could
describe the experience). My first sip of the day. With a 10.5 percent alco-
hol content, it tasted like a shot of liquor.

As I finished, I interviewed several people. One young lady eyed the
residue on my glass. "So, like, you're drinking?" "Um, you cover a beer
festival without drinking."

With that, I quickly jumped into the nearest line that offered an IPA. A cou-

ple of sips of Red Hook Longhammer made it all better. For the next hour
or so, I sipped, milled, chatted and stood in lines. I ran into Devin Boothe,
a typical 20-something hipster festival-goer, and his three friends.

"Wait a minute," I said. "You're at a festival with all of these incredible
beers and you're wearing a Pabst Blue Ribbon headband?"

"I'm glad you called him out on that one," said one of the friends.

It was all in good fun. And besides, Boothe was wearing a Smuttynose T-
shirt. It was about an hour and a half in, and let's just say I had found the
tents I wanted to visit. I was talking to one of the festival staff about all of
the "good material" at the festival.

"Have you seen the monks?"

It seems that every year, some guys dress up in full
trappist monk garb and go crazy over some
Chimay. Or something like that. I wanted to find
them, to interview them, to photograph them. The
beer was starting to get to me. (Don't worry, I was
responsible.) But I was determined to find those
monks. By now, long lines were form-
ing at pretty much every tent, which
meant I was trying to cut through a
thicket of hopped-up humanity, and I
wasn't even getting any beer out of it!
Let's just cut to the chase and say I'll
have to catch the monks next year.

Finally, I can't finish without mention-
ing that festival
